The Association has assumed National character and constituted State Chapter in almost all States and Union Territories of the country. AIMLTA is the only "Apex Body" of Medical Laboratory Technologists of India which is working its best to promote Medical Laboratory Technology and the profession in the best interest of the Technologists of India.

The Technologist all over the country came forward, joined hands and established **Indian Medical Laboratory Technologists Association (IMLTA) in the year 1970**. As the founder members realized that this association shall be part of all States and Union Territories, the
